All Pinecones take the space of one to four of the individual leaves depending on placement on the tree.

Engraving is not included in the cost. Leaves will be limited to four lines with approximately 16 to 20 characters per line. For all leaves and pinecones the cost is .40 per letter.

One of the beneficiaries of the proceeds from the EVERGREEN TREE OF LIFE campaign will be the various ministries of St. Luke parish, many of which do a great deal of work but have no specific funding source of their own. Also, as we look toward St. Luke Parish's 50th Anniversary in 2012, some capital improvement projects may be possible with the proceeds from this project.

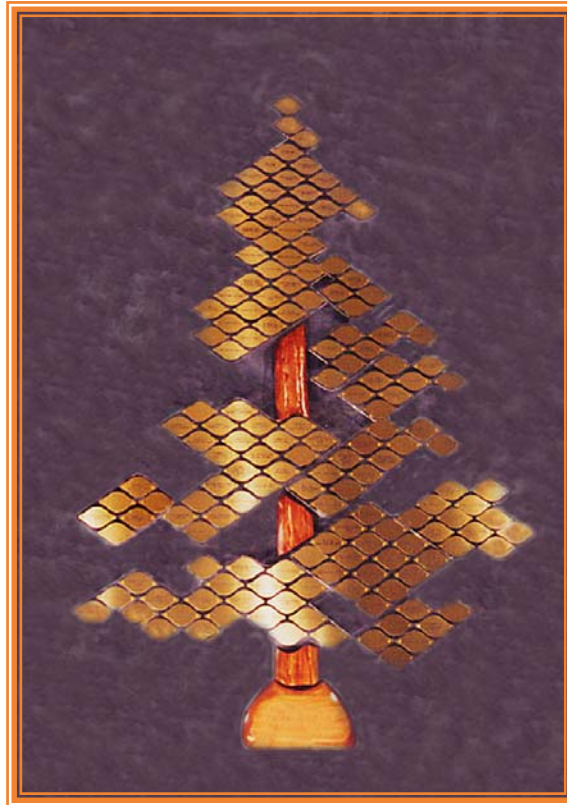
Haiku

Many significant events in our lives come and go so quickly. In a flash they seem to be gone from our memories. St. Luke Church will now offer a way to memorialize those moments in an original commissioned sculpture entitled the

EVERGREEN TREE OF LIFE

The sculpture takes the shape of an evergreen tree flourishing with full boughs of pine needle clusters. The pine tree, an evergreen, endures and survives all seasons. It survives the storms, it sheds the snow, and lives on, and continues to grow. Renewing itself in the spring, the tree is a symbol of Our Savior, Life, and the promise of the Resurrection. It continues to produce the pinecones, seeds for the future.

The trunk of the tree is carved bas-relief mahogany and grows out of a special inscription base. The sculpture includes 100 individual recognition

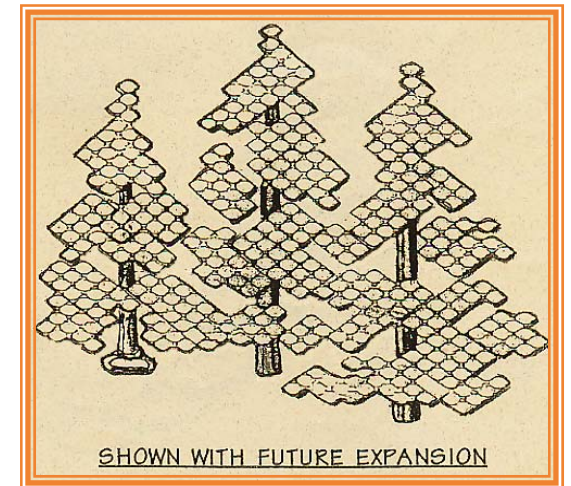


pine needle clusters, or leaves, with a brushed satin finish. Also available are special gift Pinecones to acknowledge higher level gifts.

The above photo is representative of the sculpture St. Luke has commissioned. Evident are the 100 pine needle clusters, or leaves. By engraving, in addition to the names, celebrations of births, anniversaries, weddings, sacraments, graduations, new homes, honorariums, and

memorials, you are contributing to the strong sense of community that comes from sharing your life cycle events with those of other contributors and parishioners.

Our EVERGREEN TREE OF LIFE will continue to grow through the generosity of those who wish to recognize a person or event significant to their lives. The sketch below depicts the possibilities with future additions. The sculpture is designed to readily expand and meet the needs of event recognition in the life of St. Luke Parish and its parishioners.
